

# GUN TESTS REPORT CARD

## **Rock River Arms RRA LAR-6.8 Mid-Length A4 SPC1238X 6.8 SPC, \$925 GUN TESTS GRADE: F**

Assuming the failures to feed can be successfully addressed, we were still underwhelmed by the accuracy of this weapon.



## **DPMS AP4 Panther Carbine 6.8mm SPC, \$1114 GUN TESTS GRADE: F**

In dry firing, the trigger felt superior. But when live-fired, it would not reset. We resorted to loading and firing one shot at a time. Accuracy was mediocre at best.



## **Stag Arms 5L 6.8 SPC, \$1989 GUN TESTS GRADE: B+**

This carbine delivered the best accuracy. After mediocre results from its competitors, the Stag Arms 5L finally lit our enthusiasm for the 6.8 SPC AR. But we'd trade every upgrade (save for the MagPul Precision Rifle Stock) for a better trigger. With a true match-grade trigger in place, we can only dream how good this rifle could be.
