The rear sight unit's screws (arrows) required two different screwdrivers, both of odd size, to adjust windage and elevation. We thought this was an unnecessary complication.



Supplied rings were easy to mount and rock solid. This represented a considerable savings.



Strength of lockup, always a consideration for double-action revolvers, was enhanced by a detent in the crane (arrow).
