Taurus Raging Bull 444B8 44 Magnum, \$625	March 2008	Grade A: The Raging Bull was the most comfortable and accurate of three 44 Mag test guns at the lowest price.
Ruger Redhawk KRH-444 44 Magnum, \$780	Sept 2007	Grade A: Ruger's stout-looking 4-inch Redhawk cut a profile of classic lines unique to its manufacturer.
Smith & Wesson 686 Plus 357 Magnum 164194, \$790	March 2007	Grade A: Consistent, accurate, and slotted for 7 rounds of either 38 Special or 357 Magnum.
Charter Arms Bulldog Pug 44 Special, \$399	May 2007	Grade A-: We removed a burr on the end of the cylinder pin, which fixed a lockup problem.
Taurus Tracker 455SS4 45 ACP, about \$500	Sept 2008	Grade B+: Taurus offered this with different barrel lengths, and in titanium. All have been dropped from production.
Ruger Redhawk Super Redhawk KSRH-944 Magnum, \$888	March 2008	Grade B+: Extremely consistent shooter. Needed a more suitable grip. Integral scope base and rings a plus.
Smith & Wesson Mountain Gun 44 Magnum, \$1100	May 2007	Grade B: If you can tolerate a bigger gun with a short barrel, go for the Model 24.
Smith & Wesson 629 Classic 163640 44 Magnum, \$964	March 2008	Grade B: Consistent shooter with good DA and SA trigger. Not really dedicated to the needs of the hunter.
Taurus 444MULTI 44 Magnum, \$666	Sept 2007	Grade C: A 28-ounce six-shooter constructed of titanium and aluminum, a lightweight rendering of the Raging Bull.
Smith & Wesson Model 24 44 Special, \$1105	May 2007	Grade C: Reintroduced classic. In our view, not a resounding success, except for collectors.
S&W Model 325 Night Guard 45 ACP, \$1082	Sept 2008	Grade D: We could not work the DA trigger with a proper grip on the gun.
Alfa Steel 3541	March	Grade F: The double-action trigger was stiff and unpredict-
