### **Browning BPS Special Steel Field Model Pump 20 Gauge, \$370** **GUN TESTS GRADE: B+**

Quick handling, a safety on top of the receiver for easy access by either the right or left hand and a nice trigger gave the Browning the edge in this match up. While we thought the 22-inch barrel might be a little whippy, the weight of the shotgun helped provide a smooth acquisition of targets.



### **Ithaca Model 37 Ultra Featherlight Pump 20 Gauge, \$430** **GUN TESTS GRADE: D-**

Although not quite as easy to use as the Browning by left-handed shooter, the function and handling ability of the Ithaca was satisfactory. But it was more expensive, had a fixed-choke barrel, a heavy trigger pull, and some minor pump-action hitches.
