Ruger SP101 KSP-32731X .327 Magnum, \$572 GUN TESTS GRADE: A-

The adjustable rear sight gave this snubby a big-gun sight picture, and this new round offered plenty of power and versatility in a package that we think most everyone will be able to handle. But the future of this gun may be in the



hands of the munitions manufacturers. Its longevity and success likely depends on a suitable variety of ammunition remaining widely available at reasonable prices. If those ammo worries don't bother you, then consider this an A-grade gun.

Ruger SP101 KSP-3231X .32 H&R Magnum, \$572 GUN TESTS GRADE: A

This gun is ideal for those who prefer not to deal with the recoil of bigger-bore snubbies. It is accurate and strong and a very good match for frangible ammunition that can add formidable power. It is also a lot of fun to shoot.
