GUN NAME	ISSUE	GRADE & COMMENTS
Ruger MKIII6 Standard 22 LR, \$342	March 2008	Grade A+: We had the devil of a time prying this fine handgun out of our shooters' hands.
Walther P22 WAP22003 22 LR, \$375	May 2010	Grade A: If you are current Walther owner, the P22 might serve well as a lower-cost practice gun.
CZ Kadet Adapter No. 01610 22 LR, \$412	Feb 2010	Grade A: We'd highly recommend the Kadet to owners of the CZ handguns that accept it.
Kimber Rimfire Target Conversion Kit (Silver) 22 LR, \$330	Feb 2010	Grade A: We were pleased with the Kimber Target Conversion. Any owner of a single-stack could put it to good use.
Browning Buck Mark FLD Plus Rosewood UDX 22LR, \$417	Jan 2007	Grade A: Simple maintenance, great looks and accurate, this is a gun that made us want to go to shooting.
Whitney Wolverine 22 LR, \$280	May 2006	Grade A: If you need a good knock-about pistol that won't cost an arm and a leg, look into the Whitney Wolverine.
Walther P22 22 LR No. WAP22003, \$301	Feb 2006	Grade A: Completely reliable in our limited shooting, and shot very well at 15 yards.
ISSC M22 M111000 22 LR, \$400	May 2010	Grade B: We understand that a gun can have a preference for certain ammo, but we felt the M22 was too fussy.
Walther PP Sport 22 LR, about \$1100	Feb 2006	Grade B: The rare old PP Sport was a mighty accurate, thoroughly reliable, and highly desirable pistol.
Browning Buck Mark Micro Standard URX 22 LR, \$380	March 2008	Grade C+: On the range we found the Browning would not give the razor-sharp accuracy we wanted.
Beretta U22 Neos 4.5-Inch 22 LR, \$250	March 2008	Grade C: No problems with feed or function with the Neos, but we couldn't live with the lack of accuracy.
SIG Mosquito 22 LR, \$390	May 2006	Grade C: We loved the feel of this pistol in the hand, but didn't think it shot as well as it ought to have.
Sig Sauer Mosquito MOS-22-B 22 LR, \$390	May 2010	Grade F: Don't Buy it. We canceled any further testing of the Mosquito due to safety concerns.
