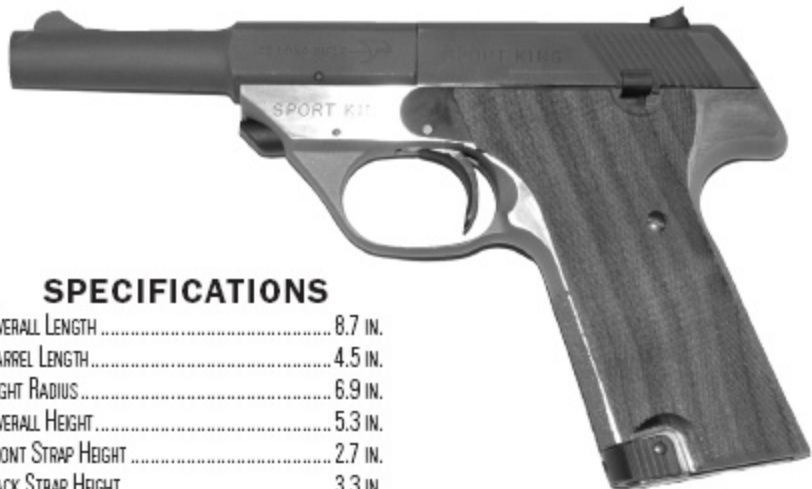


**HIGH STANDARD SPORT KING MODEL TX 9200

**GUN TESTS GRADE: D+**

A good-looking pistol with excellent workmanship and a fine trigger, the High Standard Sport King failed to come through with stellar accuracy. The problem seemed to be the barrel, which was not of the same quality as the rest of the gun. We loved the 1911-like grip shape, wood grips, and stippling. The gun had great promise but failed to deliver, in our view.

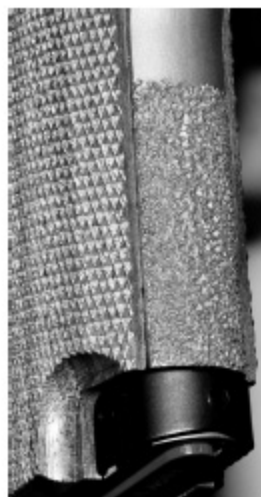
