

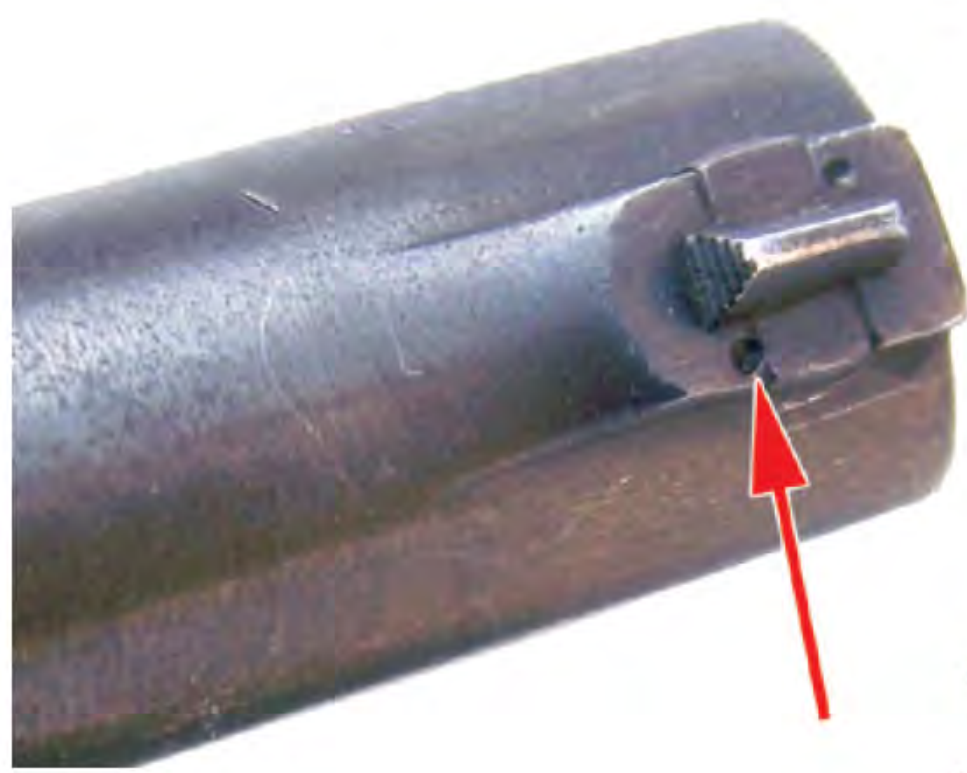
JOHN INGLIS HIGH POWER 9MM LUGER, \$650
