

**MECHTECH SYSTEMS CARBINE CONVERSION UNIT FOR GLOCK 9MM, \$505**  
**GUN TESTS GRADE: B**

This neat unit gives excellent performance. It is a good option for the Glock fan wishing to dedicate one of his pistols to the carbine concept. Commonality of trigger action is a strong point, as well as commonality with magazines. On the basis of affordability, it is a good choice, if you already have the Glock pistol on hand. Perhaps not as practical as some of the others, it is really a different bird than the other carbines, and that must be taken in consideration. The quality of work, final finish, and execution of the MechTech was flawless. This is simply a quality piece of equipment that will impress anyone who knows firearms. But it simply isn't as practical as a complete firearm, in our opinion.

Well made of the best materials, the 9mm upper assembly's main drawback is that you must first have a Glock 19 to utilize the design. Once mounted, the system works well.



We accessorized the MechTech with a three-position M4 stock. Adding a fixed carrying handle rear sight, post front sight, and adjustable stock added to the price of the conversion.



We added an AR-15 type rear sight for familiarity. The AR-15 type front sight was well suited to accurate shooting at average ranges.



The MechTech Systems conversion is an excellent choice for home defense. Well made of good material, it fits a certain niche in the scheme of things. This conversion simply broadcasted good design and execution, and the photo at left shows how far you can take the CCU. As a straight carbine, we prefer the Thureon and Sub 2000. But if you've got a Glock laying around, this conversion gives you a familiar trigger function to work with.
