Winchester Model 101 Over/Under 12 Gauge, \$900 GUN TESTS GRADE: A

The only downside to the Winchester (far right) is the fixed chokes, which could be remedied with a trip to any of the several companies that install screw-in chokes. The handling was exceptional; the hits on targets were solid; and assembly and disassembly was easy.

Charles Daly Superior Model Over/Under 12 Gauge, \$890 GUN TESTS GRADE: C

Shorter and just a little quicker to the target, we were not quite satisfied with the action of the Charles Daly (left), which locked in the quarter-open position on several occasions. We would also recommend removing the automatic safety. The fixed chokes of Improved Cylinder and Modified would be able to handle most shooting situations for birds rather than clays, but we would also suggest installing screw-in chokes if the user wants to expand the gun's bird-shooting horizons.
