Velocity was recorded at 10 feet using an Oehler 35P chronograph with proof channel. Five-shot groups were fired at 15 yards from a solid two-handed rest. Note the relatively low velocities and energies from the long-cylinder Judge.

Your pick of either 45 Long Colt or 2.5-inch 410 shotshells can be slipped into the Judge's long cylinder. The effective range with shotshells is limited, but adequate for a variety of uses. We preferred the 45 LC for self-defense, and the Judge handled them very well.
