Above: The XDM arrived in a sophisticated attaché case packed with accessories including (clockwise) three backstraps, a dual magazine pouch with adjustable tension plus Picatinny rails at both edges, an adjustable-tension belt slide holster, and possibly the best magazine loader we've tried. More XD Gear is available from Springfield Armory, including the weapon-light mount that features ambidextrous pressure switch panels.
