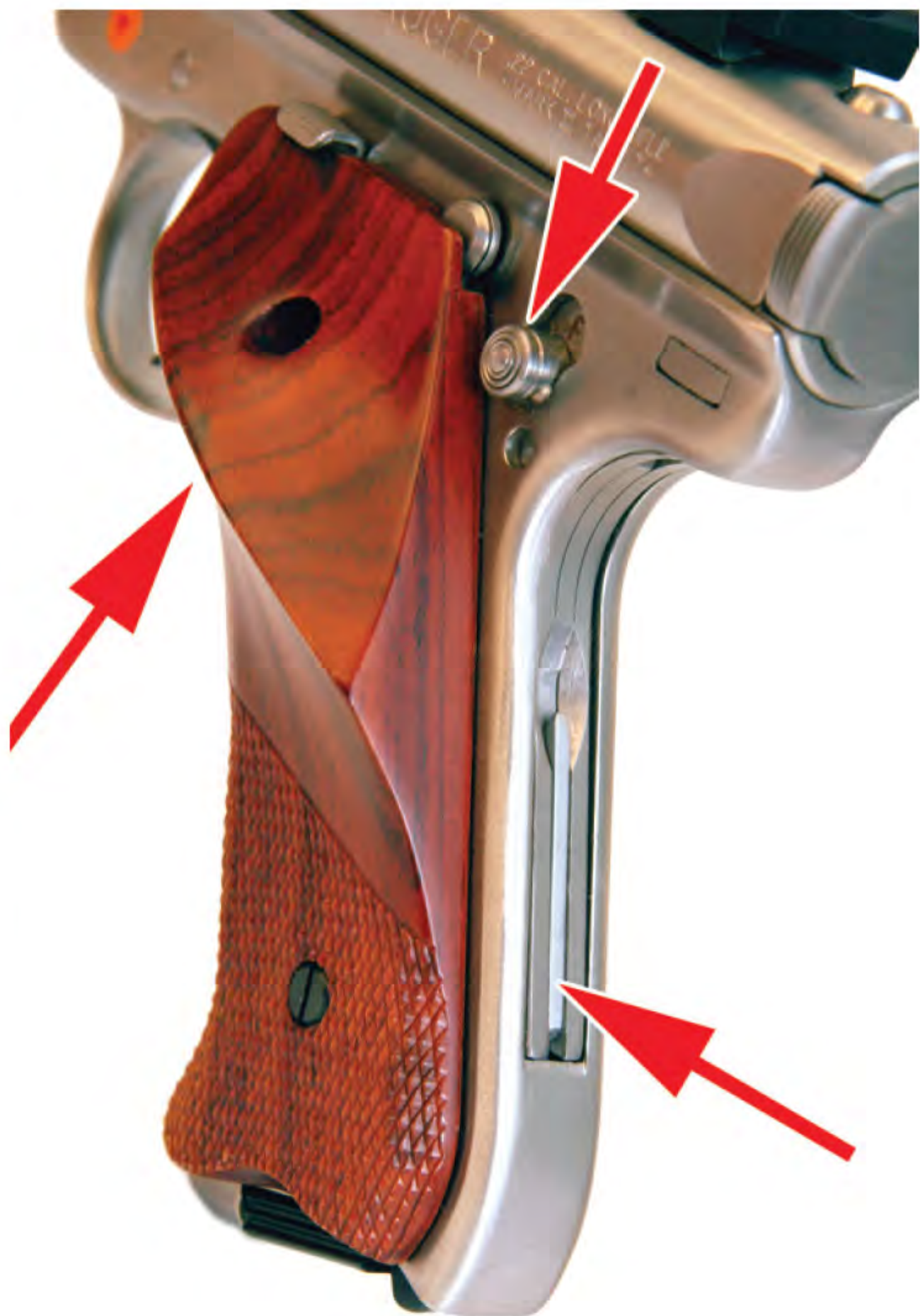

**Right: Ruger supplied a Weaver mount, connected by three screws to match the drilled-and-tapped receiver. We did not have to remove the rear sight to install a scope, but it did overhang the barrel with no additional support. The loaded-chamber indicator along the side (arrow) almost spoiled the impressive lines of the Mark III pistol.**



**Note the big thumb safety (top arrow). The left-side grip panel offered a large thumb rest (left arrow). The back of the grip was machined to feel smooth in the hand, but this is where field-stripping began. The lever in the center (right arrow) is pulled down first.**

**The rear sight, perched atop the receiver, required two different-size screwdrivers to adjust (bottom and right arrows). The bolt-stop pin was located directly behind the rear sight (left arrow).**
