The TruGlo tritium front sight provided a glowing dot. Ambient

light was picked up from the top, but in the dark a tritium module located in the front powered the green optic fiber.

Right: The TruGlo tritium front sight was not properly seated, which could cause it to fall off or be damaged.



The oversized basepad on the P229 magazine (center) is what accounts for the "Super Capacity" name. It added about 0.6 inches of height to the pistol and held 14 rounds. A 12-round magazine is to the right and a 10-round magazine with capped basepad is on the left.
