Left: We discovered there was no substitute for the Bo-Mar style sights found on the Springfield shown here. It also offered a more effectively beveled magazine well. The Range Officer was also our top shooter from the 25-yard bench. Tru Spec's \$52 24-7 pants and \$50 Uniform Shirt formed a breathable skin, which came in handy when the hot weather in Texas turned unexpectedly rainy. Zipper and Velcro closable from bottom or top, there were plenty of trick concealment pockets hidden in the shirt.

Right: For better access to the magazine release, we replaced the left-side panel. Our custom grip panel was thinner, slightly different in contour, and featured a relief to guide the shooter's thumb. A similar panel is standard equipment on some of Springfield Armory's upgraded models.
