*The Olympic K9's A2 flash hider (bottom) was longer than the bird-cage models found on the Bushmaster and Rock River products. Those wanting a change to a full compensator should leave installation to the manufacturer.*



*The 9mm K9 was pretty well disguised as a typical A2 with fully adjustable carry handle rear sight and standard brass deflector. Adding material to the magazine rather than the magazine well meant that the same receiver can be used for pistol calibers as well as .223 Remington ammunition.*



*All three carbines offered adjustable-length stocks that operated in the same manner, offering six different positions with about three-quarters of an inch between stops. Moving the stock was achieved by pressing upward on the spring-loaded catch (arrow) and sliding the stock in and out along the buffer tube.*
