Our 16x Leupold Mk 4 is way too much scope for this simple rifle, but it helped us prove its worth. Although there's nothing fancy here, this U.S.-made rifle got our respect. About all we'd change would be to get the trigger about 2 pounds lighter. This is solid value in a no-frills rifle, and we came to like and respect it.

The laminated stock was proud of the metal everywhere, which would allow for refinishing over the years. We would have liked a slimmer grip. The checkering was well done.
