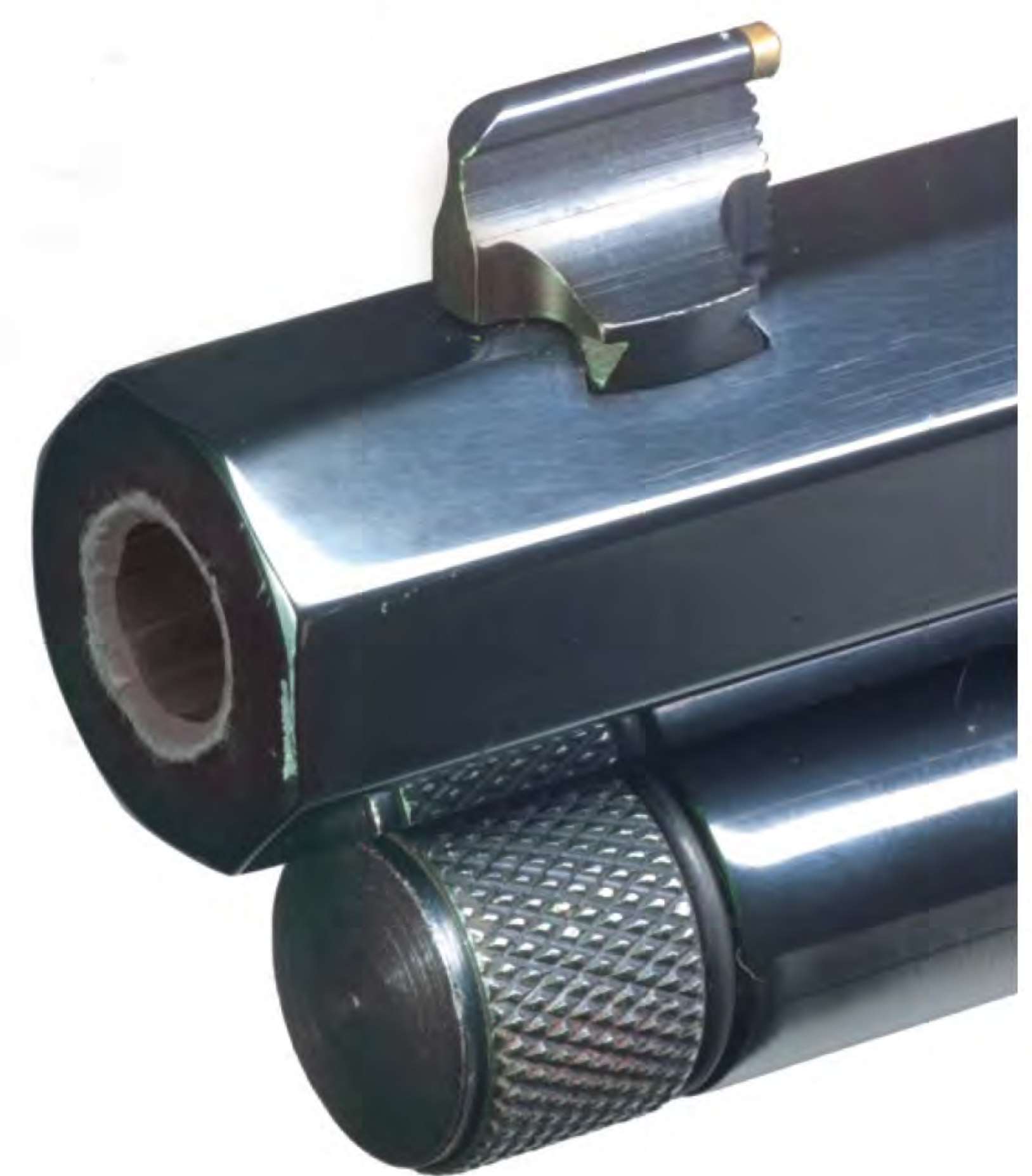
Left: Side ejection would make a scope right at home, but we'd never scope this handsome rifle.

Left and below: The wood finish on the Big boy buttstock was complete, with no open pores. The muted clearcoat glowed on the wood, which had a pretty rich-red brown tone we liked.



The Henry muzzle measured 0.83 inches across the flats, which put a lot of weight out front. It didn't affect handling, we said.
