We thought the Five's lines looked much like other Remington rifles. Like them, it worked very well. The slim bolt required a stretch forward with the trigger hand. All the metal was blued steel, sights, magazine and all. A more suitable scope

would mount farther forward, and let you retain the iron sights.

Right: Clean, borderless checkering did a fine job and looked good in the process. The semi-gloss stock finish looked almost like an oil finish, and was well done.
