The barrels on the Beretta EL Gold Pigeon are separated from the block to about where the forend ends, contributing to the forwardheavy feel of this gun.

We thought the pad on the Beretta, though fitted well, could have been finished better, both on the pad's edges and in several places along the wood where a few more passes with the sandpaper would have evened things out.
