the oddest place we've seen this switch located, but it worked just fine and was never in the way of the shooter's trigger finger.

The F3's checkering was also a bit unusual, both in its pattern.

bit unusual, both in its pattern laid out on the stock and in the checkering itself, which was loose and round. Yet, we found it offered good purchase for the trigger-finger hand.

The F3's only physical enhancement was its beautiful stock, which bore a well-figured piece of wood that shimmered when turned in the light.

The F3's barrels sported a lowprofile rib and integral fiberoptic sight. The gun came with extended choke tubes, which were clearly identified with the choke constriction and color-coding.
