GUN TESTS RECOMMENDS: BUY IT

We liked this gun a lot. It seemed to be the best compromise of weight, and with its hand-filling grips, handled the hot ammo well. Accuracy was lacking with soft lead bullets, but was probably adequate for any self-defense use. We missed night sights, though. Workmanship was excellent and the SA trigger was outstanding, but we got bad glare off the frame in the sun.
