GUN TESTS GRADE: A

Looking pretty plain, the ArmaLite was a fairly accurate rifle, with free-floating heavy stainless barrel and a decent trigger.



The magazines fit perfectly, unlike those of the M1A. The pistol grip was standard. A Picatinny rail permitted the easy installation of any type of sight. The trigger guard could be opened to permit use of gloves while firing, a potentially dangerous practice.

The back of the ArmaLite's stock held the mil-spec trap, a useful thing that was missing from the M1A.

Right: The bottom of the comfortable forend had seven tapped holes so the shooter could move the sling-attach point to his preferred location.



The circular aluminum forend simply stopped short of the gas-port block. The thick barrel got thicker from the port to the receiver. This was a heavy rifle.
