

## SIG SAUER CARRY SCORPION 45 ACP, \$1213

### GUN TESTS GRADE: B+

The SIG Carry Scorpion is a reliable, accurate, and powerful handgun. The SIG proved quite accurate; it simply wasn't as accurate as the Kimber pistol. The addition of Cerakote coating and a frame rail may cause some shooters to lean toward buying the Scorpion. The G10 scaled grips were a good feature. If you want a 1911 rail gun, then the Scorpion is a good choice.
