**GUN TESTS GRADE: C+** 

This pump's workhorse appearance and rough action caused us a little concern from the beginning. Even after firing several hundred rounds through the shotgun, it just was not as smooth as the other two, and its performance on the range and at the patterning board was disappointing.



The action release on the front of the trigger guard requires more hand movement than a release at the back of the guard but was considered a minor inconvenience. We did find that the release was a little stiff, even after several hundred rounds had been fired through the new shotgun.



The Weatherby's small forearm is typical of a quite a few slideaction shotguns on the market today. We also encountered more short-shucking (failure to feed a second round) with the Weatherby than with the other two models.

The Weatherby's takedown was simple and quick, just like the other two shotguns. The extended lug at the end of the barrel reached well into the PA-08's chamber and provided a solid lock-up.



Standard and plain, we felt the stock was adequate for a bargain-priced pump. The very hard recoil pad did not provide a lot of recoil relief, particularly with waterfowl loads.
